



# 2020 US OPEN GOLF POOL

The 2020 US Open is being held in our very own backyard this year. The 120<sup>th</sup> golf US Open championship will be played at Winged Foot Golf Club in Mamaroneck. Golfers tee off on Thursday, September 17<sup>th</sup> and the final round is played on Sunday, September 20<sup>th</sup>. Unfortunately, there will be no inperson galleries this year due to COVID-19 restrictions, however you can enjoy the fun and follow along by participating in this contest. Not a lot of people enjoy watching golf on TV, but now you have a reason to tune in. You do not need to have knowledge about the game of golf or the golfers to participate.

Basic info. regarding the actual golf: All golfers that are playing in the tournament play 18 holes on Thursday and 18 holes on Friday. These first two rounds are used to see who plays well enough to play on Saturday and Sunday. Golfers who do not score well enough on the first days are "cut" and they only allow the top scorers to compete the rest of the weekend. The standard cut line for a golf event after two rounds is the score of the 70th lowest scoring professional. Any golfers that finish with that score or better are considered to have "made the cut." So the more players you pick in this pool that "make the cut", the better chance you have at finishing at the top of the pool. Remember, the lower number a golfer scores during a golf game, the better.

#### Here's how to play:

- --Included with this form is a list of all the players scheduled to participate in the golf tournament. The list is broken into three (3) "divisions" listed as A, B and C.
- --You must pick two (2) players from division A, two (2) players from division B and three (3) players from division C. Seven (7) total golfers must be chosen.
- --A spreadsheet that lists everyone's seven choices will be put together by the organizer of the pool. The four best final golf scores from your chosen seven will be what we will

use to determine the winners of the pool. If someone's seven choices only has three golfers that make the cut, you will be designated a score of 10 over par (80) for your fourth so we can have four scores to tally. So once again, the more players you choose that make the cut, the better chance you have finishing at the top.

I realize the scoring might be confusing for those who have never done a golf pool before, but basically you want to choose golfers that not only make the cut, but also end up towards the top of the final leaderboard on Sunday when the US Open ends.

Prizes: 1<sup>st</sup> place finisher: 50% of the pot 2<sup>nd</sup> place finisher: 25% of the pot 3<sup>rd</sup> place finisher: 15% of the pot WRAPS: 10% of the pot (This contest is a WRAPS fundraising effort).

How to enter: Fill out the registration form with your seven golfers and return to Matt Arone via e-mail at <a href="mailto:marone@sleepyhollowny.org">marone@sleepyhollowny.org</a>. You can also just e-mail Matt your seven golfers without the form if it is easier.

All entries must be received by Thursday, September 17th by 8:00am!!!!
